Capacity Receives Grant to Develop a Pluggable Hybrid Electric Terminal Tractor

Capacity of Texas announces the award of a \$722,000 Grant to develop a Pluggable Hybrid Electric Terminal Tractor (PHETT). The project is supported by the State of Texas through a Grant from the Texas Environmental Research Consortium and the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality. The project involves developing a Diesel/Electric system which will increase fuel efficiency by 60 to 70 percent while reducing emissions by over 90 percent.

“As a leader in the terminal tractor industry, we are pleased to receive the grant from the state of Texas to develop a Pluggable Hybrid Electric Terminal Tractor. The development of this product will reduce emissions at all Ports, Intermodal Yards and Warehousing/Distribution Centers not only in North America but throughout the world. Capacity of Texas is dedicated to environmental stewardship by improving our product with the latest technology in electronics, engines and green propulsion,” stated Phillip Ford, President of Capacity of Texas.

The PHETT will be developed in conjunction with Alternative Motive Power Systems, LLC (AMPS) of Alexandria, OH. AMPS proprietary control and power management systems makes them an industry leader in Green Motive Power. The PHETT will be capable of operating in either a generator set “charge sustaining” hybrid mode or in “zero-emissions” mode using grid power.

In addition to the PHETT, which will be available in 2nd quarter 2009, Capacity of Texas is the only manufacturer that offers CNG and LNG product that utilizes the Cummins Westport ISLG, which meets U.S. EPA and CARB 2010 emissions standards.

Capacity of Texas, Inc., based in Longview, Texas, is a wholly owned subsidiary of Collins Industries, Inc., and is the largest American owned manufacturer of terminal tractors in North America, offering a full product line of terminal trucks used throughout
